

Dear Students and Parents,

I hope you are all doing well and staying healthy. The staff of Grand Mesa Choice Academy has been working in conjunction with Delta County School District's leadership team in planning the remainder of the school year. Following is the outline:

- Formal distance learning begins March 30th.
 - If you are in the regular block your teachers will push lectures and assignments out to you through Google Classroom.
 - If you are in SOAR, you will continue your Edgenuity classes. Mrs. Lang will monitor the classes and keep in contact with you.
 - If you are in 11th hour you will continue your Edgenuity classes. Mrs. Seaney will monitor the classes and keep in contact with you.
- Teachers will provide at least 4 hours a day of "office hours". All GMCA staff office hours will be from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM. Most office hours will be through video conferencing or phone calls. If a teacher or student needs to do an in-person session it can be scheduled to take place at GMCA. Please note that you'll be asked several questions regarding your health before coming into the building. This is out of concern for the entire GMCA community.
 - All social distancing guidelines will be followed.
- Mrs. Seaney will provide at least 4 hours a day of "office hours" for general questions and help. Mrs Seaney will be pushing out to students Naviance assignments as well as monitoring work study and SEL. Students please check your student emails at least once per day as this is how Mrs. Seaney will communicate.
- If a student needs WIFI time they may call and schedule with Mr. Ritter or Mrs. Hoshiko.
 - Times 10:15 to 11:15; 11:30 to 12:30; 1:00 to 2:00 - by appointment only - Please note that you'll be asked questions regarding your health.
 - We will disinfect surfaces between sessions.
- Chromebook check out:
 - If you need to check out a chromebook please schedule a pick up time using the above "wifi" times.
 - There is a \$35.00 collateral fee. This fee will be returned when the Chromebook is returned in good order.
- If need is demonstrated packets for classes can be provided.
 - Students will have to make arrangements with Mr. Ritter or Mrs. Hoshiko to pick up the packets. Call 970-874-6505. All packets are due every Thursday between 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM. Please call the school at 970-874-6505 to arrange a time.

- At this time, if you have passed Discovery you will be in the Core block.
- Credit has been awarded our PAC block that was cut short due to school closures.
- Once again, please check your student email at least once per day
